#### THE HOTEL BRITOMART PICKS UP MULTIPLE HONOURS AT THE PROPERTY INDUSTRY AWARDS

The Hotel Britomart scooped two categories in Property Council New Zealand’s Property Industry Awards 2021, announced last night.

The Hotel Britomart won the following awards:

- Tourism and Leisure: Excellence and Best in Category
- Heritage and Adaptive Reuses: Excellence and Best in Category
- Green Building: Excellence

The Hotel Britomart is New Zealand’s first 5 Green Star hotel, certified by the NZ Green Building Council. Opened in October 2020, it was developed by Cooper and Company and designed by Cheshire Architects. It combines a new 10-storey, brick-clad tower with the sensitive refurbishment of two adjacent heritage warehouses.

“We’re deeply honoured to receive this recognition from the Property Council and to be among the other winners, who represent excellence across the industry,” says The Hotel Britomart general manager, Clinton Farley. “A large and incredibly dedicated team worked for years to bring The Hotel Britomart to life, and it’s fantastic to see their efforts recognised. It’s also a nice way to prepare to welcome back guests as Auckland reopens next week.”



The Property Industry Awards 2021 recognise excellence in buildings that shape towns, cities and places where New Zealanders live, work, play and shop. Awards were made in nine categories, including Civic, Health and the Arts, Community and Affordable Housing, Education, Industrial, Multi-Unit Residential and Commercial Office.

These new awards add to a string of accolades The Hotel Britomart has received in its first year of operations, including a place on Conde Nast Traveler magazine's 2021 Hot List of the best new hotels in the world, and being recognised as runner up in the Sustainability category in National Geographic Traveller magazine's 2021 Hotel Awards.

The Hotel Britomart has a something new to celebrate with its post-lockdown reopening: Tuawhiti Lane, the cobbled laneway at the hotel entry, has a new glass roof, making it the perfect weatherproof outdoor dining space for people celebrating the festive season at kingi.

The hotel is also welcoming guests back with a special [Stay Green](#) package: for every booking received, The Hotel Britomart will plant a native tree at The Landing, the Bay of Islands heritage estate that is also under the stewardship of Cooper and Company, the team that created The Hotel Britomart.
